My name is Brian Heath, and I am a missionary with Rock of Ages Prison Ministry, working in prisons and public schools in the Midwest region of the United States. One way we minister to inmates is through sport crusades consisting of softball or basketball games with the inmates, a Gospel message in the prison yard, and distributing John & Romans and Gospel tracts. A couple of years ago, Bearing Precious Seed printed personalized John & Romans for us, and we have distributed nearly 10,000 in prisons in Michigan, Ohio, and Illinois during

the last two years. God has blessed these efforts by allowing us to see nearly 400 inmates respond to the Gospel invitation and publicly come forward to receive Christ as their Saviour!

Here is a brief testimony of how God used some of the John & Romans we distributed. I was preaching at a correctional facility in Michigan one Sunday evening, and an inmate came up to me after the service and related the following testimony:

"Brother Brian, you probably don't remember me, but I first met you last summer when your softball ministry came into our facility. You all were such an encouragement to me. When you were passing out the John & Romans, I asked if I could have a couple of extra copies. I sent one to my thirty-year-old daughter who lives in Florida and one to my son, who is in his late twenties and lives in Michigan. I also wrote them a letter expressing how much I desired that they trust Christ as their Saviour. In the months to follow, I received a letter from my daughter. She told me she had read through the John & Romans and had made the decision to trust Christ as her Saviour. She also told me she has been baptized and is now faithfully attending a church in her area. Then a few weeks later, I got a letter from my son who told me that he followed the marked verses of the

With tear-filled eyes he continued to express his gratitude to me for our ministry and for the John & Romans we brought. His testimony

is exactly why we pass out John & Romans at our crusades. Yes, they get to hear a gospel message during the crusade, but when you leave the Word of God in someone's hand, it will continue to preach to them long after we are gone. That is the power of the printed Word of God. I could not have gone to visit this man's children. Nor could he have traveled to them to witness to them. However, a John & Romans sent through the mail got the job done.

I believe it is of utmost importance to get the Word of God into the hands of the inmate, and it alone has the power to make a lasting change in the hearts of these men and women. I am so thankful for the ministry of BPS and for their burden to get the printed Word of God into the hands of sinners here at home and around the world. We will soon be ordering another 10,000 Scriptures for the coming season, and we look forward to seeing what God will do through them.

OTHER YEAR-TO-DATE HIGHLIGHTS:

250,200 English J/Rs, 15,094 English WBs, and 8,640 English NTs have been shipped to multiple countries.

16,800 Burmese J/Rs were shipped to Myanmar.

36,000 Arabic/English J/Rs were shipped to Europe in June for distribution among refugee camps.

135 French WBs were shipped to France.

252,500 English J/Rs, 40,150 Kannada J/Rs, 20,250 Tagalog J/Rs, and 12,500 Spanish J/Rs have been shipped to ministries in Canada.

YEAR-TO-DATE STATISTICS:

5,389,550 Scriptures have been printed through June 6th.

Twenty truckloads of paper have been used so far this year.

BPS has printed in ten languages year-to-date.

In May, BPS printed the Hebrew Old Testaments for the first time.
