His Word to the world; the goal of the Summit was to join together with like-minded ministries and seek ways to increase publishing God's Word around the world. If we cannot accomplish the task


together, why would we attempt to do it alone?

National Bible Publishing Month is a program designed to make it possible to get the Word of God to those who may never have another opportunity to receive the glorious message of our dear Saviour. NBPM is an attempt by Bearing Precious Seed Milford to ask others of like faith to partner with us to provide Scriptures for those in need. We have the ability to do the printing. We are asking others to help by providing the funds necessary for the supplies. Every dime received through NBPM is used exclusively for the purchase of paper to produce Whole Bibles and New

Testaments for missionaries all around the world.

In 2012, BPS began to highlight projects for four countries each year.
While BPS produces Scriptures for the offerings given during

numerous countries yearly, these particular countries are the focus for the offerings given during National Bible Publishing Month. This approach has helped others get involved in specific projects going to specific areas of the world. Since 2012, NBPM offerings have supplied New Testaments and Whole Bibles to the following countries:

2012—Mexico, Philippines, Southern Sudan and Zambia

2013-Armenia, Lebanon, Myanmar and Peru

2014-Nepal, Romania, Sierra Leone and Thailand


2015—Guyana, India, Liberia and Poland

2016—The Faroe Islands, Haiti, India and Sierra Leone

2017—East Africa, Papua New Guinea, Peru and Scotland

TOTAL: 310,000 Whole Bibles and 365,000 New Testaments for 21 countries

We are currently working on the projects for NBPM 2018. Two countries we plan to supply with Scripture are Wales and Japan. We will inform you of the other countries as soon as we finalize them. #### God's Word, a Catholic Priest, and Islamic Gunmen

A longtime friend of Bearing Precious Seed recently called and shared a testimony. He had shipped Bibles to Baghdad, Iraq, but they were held up at customs because the customs official said there were not enough Christians in the country to matter. It looked like the Scriptures wouldn't make it to the intended destination until a Catholic priest in Baghdad heard Bibles were being held up in customs. The priest demanded the official release the Bibles. Upon their release, they were sent

> to the intended destination which was a house in the area. After some time, gunmen came to the house and demanded the Christians living there give them their money. The Iraqi Christians told the gunmen they had no money. The gunmen replied they had been watching the house, and they had witnessed people leaving the house with boxes, so they must be selling something. The Christians responded that the boxes held Bibles and they were free. The gunmen had never heard of a Bible, and after learning what it was, they carried several boxes out to their van and left! The New Testament This story caused us to consider how God

gets His Word where He wants it and how He uses what He does to get it there. Someone gave financially for these Arabic Bibles: they were printed, and someone took care of shipping them to their destination. Then God used a Catholic priest and some Islamic gunmen to get these Bibles into places we could never go and to people we could never reach. As always, only God receives the glory, because only He can do itIII


summer in several years! We were able to partner with seventeen different churches, and ten of those churches had never been on a missions trip with BPS El Paso before. We are so

With over 300 guests, we were able to cover more areas in Juarez and on the Navajo reservations. The two fruits of this blessing are more Scriptures distributed and more people invited to the evangelistic services. We may not know in this life how many souls have been saved, but we are grateful for the opportunity to share the Gospel with the lost.

One exciting highlight of this summer concerned the different churches. Of the seventeen churches that participated this summer, four of them had never even been on a missions trip of any kind. Those groups shared how they were a little nervous about the trip but very quickly were grateful for how everything was going. We were able to hear from new and old churches alike how great a missions trip with BPS El Paso is—both for a church which has never been on a missions trip and also for a church that regularly goes on missions trips. Group leaders expressed their appreciation for the logistics covered by BPS El Paso, allowing them to enjoy the trip with their missions team.

On July 25, 1985, as a six-year-old boy, I received the Lord Jesus Christ as my personal Saviour at the Delaware Correctional Center in Smyrna, Delaware. My dad was a Chaplain there for over 30 years, and our family would go into the prison for services.

As a teenager, I surrendered my life to do whatever the Lord wanted me to do. In the fall of 1994, Carlos Demarest came to our church and presented the ministry of Bearing Precious Seed of El Paso, Texas. He invited our church to go on a mission trip to Mexico. I signed up for the trip and spent a week in El Paso and Mexico in the Summer of 1995. It was on that trip that the Lord began speaking to my heart about the ministry of BPS and what I could do to be a part of this ministry. I went back to El Paso in 1996 and 1997. After graduating in 1997 and spending the summer in El Paso, I felt I should just stay and work in the print shop and not return home to Delaware. I spoke to my parents about my desire and my dad encouraged me to come home, help out on the family farm, and talk to my pastor about what I felt the Lord calling me to do. After spending much time in prayer and talking with my Pastor, Eldon Fowler,


about what I felt the Lord leading me to do, he and my home church, Capitol Baptist Church of Dover, Delaware, sent me out of their church as a missionary to work with the ministry of BPS El Paso. On May 8, 1998, I started working with this great ministry—printing, assembling and distributing the Word of God. Seventeen years ago, I met my wife in El Paso, and the Lord has blessed us with six adopted children.

In 2015, Pastor Duttry approached me and asked me to come work at BPS Milford and use my experience to run the binding production in Milford. Needless to say, this was a very difficult decision for me, because I had invested eighteen years at the EI Paso location. After much prayer, fasting and seeking the Lord, my wife and I both had peace about the decision, and on August 15, 2016, we moved to Milford, Ohio. I am so thankful to be a part of this great ministry, and every day I look forward to printing and putting God's Word together. The verse the Lord has used in my life is found in I Corinthians 15:34, "Awake to righteousness, and sin not; for some have not the knowledge of God: I speak this to your shame."
