FIRST QUARTER HIGHLIGHTS

During the first three months, we were able to print 4,000,000 copies of Scripture.

➤ We have printed Scripture in ten languages (English, French, French Creole, Ilonggo, Lithuanian, Nepali, Portuguese, Russian, Spanish and Thai).

► So far in 2019, we have printed 55,000 whole Bibles and 40.310 New Testaments.

► We have produced 322,000 personalized John & Romans for eight churches in five foreign countries.

- ▶ We have used about sixteen truckloads of paper so far this year.
- ▶ Praise the Lord for some answers to prayer about paper cost. We have been able to buy some paper for Bibles at 60% of current paper costs. We were able to secure 150,000 lbs. at this 40% savings. Paper has increased in costs, but God has redirected some to us at a reduced cost!
- ▶ While we have had some problems with our equipment, Valley Machine Tool in Morrow, Ohio, was able to help us with some machining issues, saving quite a bit on our repair expenses.
- Some new equipment has been added to the print shop.



PRAYER REQUESTS:

- ▶ We have 25,000 English Bibles at our bindery that will be assembled in the next two weeks, followed by 10,000 Russian Bibles, 8,000 Ilonggo Bibles and 25,000 English New Testaments. Keep the shop in your prayers to run efficiently and safely.
- ▶ Please continue to pray for the men in the shop as they work tirelessly to keep the presses and other equipment running.
- ▶ Pray for the volunteers who come in almost daily to help run the bindery or assemble John & Romans. They are heavily involved in the ministry and continue to help get millions of copies of Scripture to the world.

Each year, *Bearing Precious Seed* missionaries travel thousands of miles presenting the ministry to a number of churches all across the country. Please pray for continued safety for all those who travel to represent BPS.

EQUIPMENT UPDATE:



- ▶ We have added a Miller 5-color sheet-fed press with a coater (pictured at left). It is over twenty years newer than the Miller 4-color press it replaced. It is installed and running well.
- ➤ We have installed a new pre-melter on our bindery line.
- ▶ In early April, the clutch went out on the web press, causing about a week of downtime while we waited for the part to be repaired.
- Around that same time, the bindery had a bearing go out and we needed to repair a shaft that was worn. These repairs caused the bindery to be down for more than a week.
- ➤ We are hoping to purchase a Slitter/Creaser in the near future. It will improve efficiency and quality.
- ▶ We are also looking to purchase a roll stand for the Didde press which will increase efficiency while printing large quantities of covers.

CONSIDER THIS:

- ► We had two weeks of downtime at the beginning of the year for routine maintenance.
- ► At normal speed, 68 pounds of paper run through the press each minute.
- ▶ Based on the paper used, the press ran 15,131 minutes through the first three months of the year.
- ▶\$37.50 worth of paper runs through the press each minute.
- ▶ 15,131 minutes equaled \$567,415 worth of paper.
- ▶ The press has run 252 hours in the last eleven weeks, for an average of 23 hours per week.
- ▶ At the current rate we are running, if enough paper could be purchased, we could run 2.3 million pounds, or 58 truckloads, of paper by the end of the year.
- ▶ To print at our current rate, we will need to purchase three times the amount of paper we have run to this point.
- ▶ If we continued to print at our current rate, we would print approximately 14 million copies of Scripture this year.


