Due to Covid-19, we are living in uncertain times where people are hesitant to accept a piece of Gospel literature, where face to face soul-winning is challenging, and Christians are just unsure of what all they can do for the cause of Christ in reaching the lost. The world around us is living in fear. There could not be a better time for us to reach them! We should all be asking ourselves the question, "What can I do **right now** to reach the lost in the United States?" We have a plan that is working and we would like to share that with you.

In 2018, I attended a preachers' meeting where a pastor shared his testimony of how the Lord was using his ministry to mail John & Romans into every home in Canada. Dr. Al Stone with *Bearing Precious Seed Canada* explained that in 15 years they have already reached half the homes in Canada with 6.5 million copies of John & Romans. The Lord began working on

my heart about reaching every home in the United States in this very same way.


Although our church is a strong supporter of world-wide missions and Bible-printing ministries, the question I could not shake was, "Is the Word of God getting into every home in the United States?" It's sad to say, but we now live in a country where even in rural towns, there are many who don't know what the Bible is or who Jesus is. Many times churches distribute John & Romans door to door, which is a wonderful thing to do, but seldom do people go beyond their city limits. This is why **The American Gospel Project** was started. The desire of the AGP is to work county by county beginning in the states of Ohio and Indiana and get a copy of John & Romans with a clear plan of salvation into every home, using the United States Postal Service!

After assembling the John & Romans in a Seedline project, the cost of printing and mailing each copy of John & Romans was only **\$0.33**! For less than a postcard stamp we can get the Gospel into the homes of our fellow Americans. Already over 60,000 John & Romans have been mailed in four counties in Ohio and Indiana. Several people have contacted the *American Gospel Project* saying they accepted Jesus Christ through this ministry! Others are looking for local churches and we are able to help them in that area as well.

These John & Romans booklets are designed with a patriotic cover that can be used in every county. The cover of these booklets has a QR code to the *AGP* website, www.theamericangp.com. On this website, they will find a video with a clear plan of salvation by evangelist Scott Pauley. People are able to contact the *AGP* if they make a decision for Christ, want to know more about salvation or are just looking for a church near them. That is where the local church comes in! Once we find out where these people live, we will contact a local church so they are able to follow up on them and help them grow in the Lord.

At the current time, we are looking to add another Web press. This will enable us to dedicate our current press to solely printing John & Romans, and keep the newer press set up to print New Testaments and Bibles. An additional press will allow us to produce more Bibles than in the past. It will not only eliminate between 30 and 40 days of downtime for changeovers alone, but it will also decrease the amount

of wasted paper between changeovers and set ups.

In the last 10 years God has supplied over \$800,000 worth of equipment for about \$80,000! He continues to supply what we need when we need it. Please pray that if this newer press is God's will, He will provide and allow it to be here in early 2021. Some of the funds needed for the press have already been provided, and some folks have said they would like to help with the project. I believe we have seen God's hand in each piece of equipment that has been added to the ministry, and each addition has helped do more to get His Word to the world. We look forward to giving testimony of how God provided for this next big addition to the ministry of Bearing Precious Seed!


200,000,000 PRINTED



What a blessing it is to be able to report that on September 3, 2020, we printed the 200 millionth copy of Scripture at *Bearing Precious Seed* in Milford, Ohio. It is God's Word and it is for His Glory!

We have printed 6,295,000 copies of Scripture in nine languages this year. In July, *Bearing Precious Seed* printed New Testaments for Malawi in the Chichewa language for the first time. We will soon begin printing whole Bibles in the Kiribati language, which will be the first time *BPS* has printed in that language.
