



- ► Though prices have increased, paper has continued to be delivered for the presses.

- ► We are thankful for ongoing help from faithful volunteers and visiting groups; we could not do it without them!

- ► Replacement of our binder at some point. Though still running well, due to its age, parts are often hard to find.
- ► Safe passage for Scripture as it is shipped around the world.
- ▶ Ukrainian Scriptures as they are distributed to the people in Ukraine and the surrounding countries.
- ▶ Ongoing support and funds for paper; we still have matching funds dollar-for-dollar at this time.
- ► Volunteers at the shop; they are vital to what happens here as Scripture is produced.




Philippians 4:19 "But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus."

The last few years have been trying in many ways. Where were you when Covid actually started for you? I was in Arizona, and things started happening very quickly. Remember the unknown feeling of what was going to take place and how long it would last? We all know folks it affected in many different ways. Recall more recently the empty store shelves and not seeing the familiar items you are accustomed to seeing? We are now aware of the continual supply chain issues and not getting what we are used to in a timely manner. Bearing Precious Seed is dealing with the ongoing results of the containers that are not able to be unloaded as well as the shortage of drivers to move goods around the country. At last count, I heard there was a shortage of 80,000 truck drivers. BPS continues to endure delays in necessary items, tremendous price increases, and requested items simply not attainable. However, through all of this, we are having the highest production across the press we have ever had so far. As of June 1st, 5,984,020 copies of Scripture have been produced this year in fourteen languages! We have had to do some things a bit differently due to certain paper not being available, but God continues to take care of the need. Ultimately, we are reminded daily that it is His Word, and He continues to supply what

Dr. Larry Gene Stallings 1941 - 2022

In 1973, the *First Baptist Church* in Milford, Ohio began printing the Word of God. The idea of involving other churches in hands-on Bible publishing was introduced and a businessman from South Carolina made it happen. In the earliest days of *Bearing Precious Seed*, churches traveled to Milford where they assisted in assembling, stapling, and trimming. The result was sensational as the participation took hands-on Bible publishing to a new level - the personal level. However, with the amount of Scripture rolling off the press in Milford, more help was needed. Dr. Larry Stallings was God's appointed man for such a time. A southern gentleman whose business experience lent itself to the vital aspect of team-building, he practiced "networking" before it was a common term inter-connecting local churches. Dr. Stallings began to haul Scriptures and equipment around the country where assembly projects happened, and fellow-believers joyfully became part of a local church movement changing hearts and lives at home and across the globe. Beginning with the involvement of three churches, he pioneered the path and shaped the ministry that is today known as *Seedline*. Now, over 250 churches in the US and Canada actively assemble Scriptures on their own property.

For 25 years, Dr. Stallings led the Seedline ministry and fostered an atmosphere of partnership among local churches. He quoted Henry Ford in reference to Seedline: "Coming together is a beginning. Keeping together is a process. Thinking together is unity. Working together is success." The gold standard instituted by Dr. Larry Stallings and the Seedline ministry is a unified effort in seeing God's Word go forth to the regions beyond.

European countries bordering Ukraine have recently received hundreds of thousands of Ukrainian refugees fleeing war. Missionaries and workers in those countries began to ask for Ukrainian Scriptures that could be used to give individuals the hope and peace which is only found in Christ Jesus.

Two local churches in southwest Florida, *Tri-city Baptist Church* of Port Charlotte and *First Baptist Church* of North Port, answered the call and joined together to assemble 100,000 Ukrainian John & Romans in three days.

We were overwhelmed--not by the task at hand, but by the outpouring of volunteers from **ten** local churches. Many volunteers were Ukrainians themselves, including a pastor from *Ukrainian Baptist Church*. Volunteers kept pouring in throughout the day and into the late evening. We ran out of tables, but God is faithful. After a thirteen-hour



day, we were halfway done with the project. The spirit of love and the commonality of standing for the Gospel was palpable in the small fellowship hall filled wall-to-wall with God's people doing this vital work. Amazingly and by God's grace, we finished day two at 6:45 PM, right before the evening prayer service. 100,000 Ukrainian John & Romans were completed in two days! "For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations." Psalm 100:5

This transformational project brought many together in fellowship and peace as a church. We were encouraged and inspired to do another project for God's glory. Caasa Fory!
