privilege to know Him, to serve Him, and to be used by Him.

The new press is up and running. So far, it has yet to run at full speed, but it has been kept at a slower speed as we get all the needed adjustments made. Yet several weeks ago, we were able to run it simultaneously with our old press. When we did so, we were printing a total of 96,000 John & Romans an hour! I walked through the shop and saw over 250 rolls of paper ready to go, and it's AMAZING!

It has been amazing to look back at 2021 and see how the Lord has supplied for the furtherance of the Gospel.

♦ The Goss press was installed early in the year, and the press dedication was May 2nd. This press is able to run six rolls of paper at one time, reducing the time involved in printing and binding. The Spanish whole Bible was the

first Bible printed on this press; it will only require one pass on our binder.

◆ November 3rd marked the first time that we were able to run all six webs on the new press. That equates to 192 pages printed at one time on the press. Glory to God for His provision and continued supply!



♦ We have printed Scripture in fourteen languages this year. Also, for the first time ever, we were able to print the


Simte Whole Bible for India, the Tswana New Testament for South Africa, and the Malagasy John & Romans for Madagascar.

♦ With two presses now running, there is a greater need for paper. God knew that before He supplied the new press! In April, we had a donor pledge \$250,000 per year


in matching funds over the next four years. Five months later, the first of the four annual gifts was matched. We started working immediately on the second gift. God continues to supply!

◆ Paper costs have increased significantly, but we have been able to purchase quite a bit of paper at reduced prices due to the gifts given for paper. We have more paper on the floor right now than ever before; however, we can go through a truckload of paper in just over a day when both presses are running at full capacity.

THE EFFECT OF SLOWER SUPPLIES

You have likely heard about supply chain issues, ships waiting offshore, and the effects these are having on the retail market. We have certainly seen some delays on obtaining certain supplies, but all glory goes to God that the delays have not stopped us from being able to continue to print God's Word. We have seen some delays in the delivery of needed parts from time to time. The supply chain issues have impacted the supplies needed for the leather Bibles we produce; therefore, we are currently out of a few of the Bibles we typically offer. Please understand that the vast majority of the

Scriptures produced at *Bearing Precious Seed* is for the mission field and is supplied to missionaries and foreign churches at no cost to them. The production of our leather Bibles is in response to those of you desiring a quality Bible printed by a local church rather than a secular company that simply seeks to turn a profit and gives no thought to the spiritual importance of what they print. Continue to visit our website to see what is available.


Despite the supply chain issues, we continue to be able to ship, albeit we have seen some extended ship times domestically and overseas. We currently have one container headed to India and one headed to Malawi which is scheduled to arrive in port on January 3rd. Pray for both of these containers, as well as others that are pending. The shipment of thirteen crates of New Testaments have made it to their destinations throughout Europe, praise the Lord!

RETIREDA

Sam Caudill was the first pressman for Bearing Precious Seed back in 1973. He was saved in 1965, surrendered to missions in 1970, graduated from Bible college in 1973, and immediately began deputation to become a missionary to Mexico. While Sam was in the process of raising his final support and leaving for Mexico, Dr. Charles Keen was burdened to start a printing ministry at First

Baptist Church. However, he didn't have anyone to print the Bibles, and Sam volunteered to help until their time to leave for the mission field. Dr. Keen asked Bro. Caudill to pray about staying and running the press at BPS. After much prayer, Bro. Sam felt the Lord was redirecting his steps, and he served at BPS from 1973-1978. In 1979 he continued his deputation and then served as a missionary in Mexico from 1982-1991. In 1992, he returned to Milford and became the General Director of BPS where he has served faithfully since then.

> In June 2013, FBC celebrated Sam Caudill Day. It was kind of a precursor to Bro. Sam retiring after serving the Lord faithfully for 40 years. Sam continued to come to work just like normal for the next six years. Finally, he started taking some Fridays off, but continued to help us go forward. A few months ago, he said he thought he needed to step away from his duties here at BPS. The funny thing is he now volunteers on the bindery line when we are binding Bibles. His knowledge of the printing

process makes him an invaluable resource. He continues to be a blessing, and is and always will be a big part of Bearing Precious Seed. Thank you, Bro. Sam, for the many years of faithful service and your continued involvement in helping get Scripture around the world-210 million and counting.
